

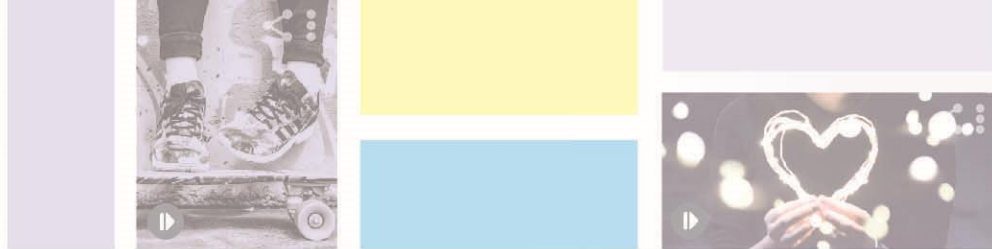

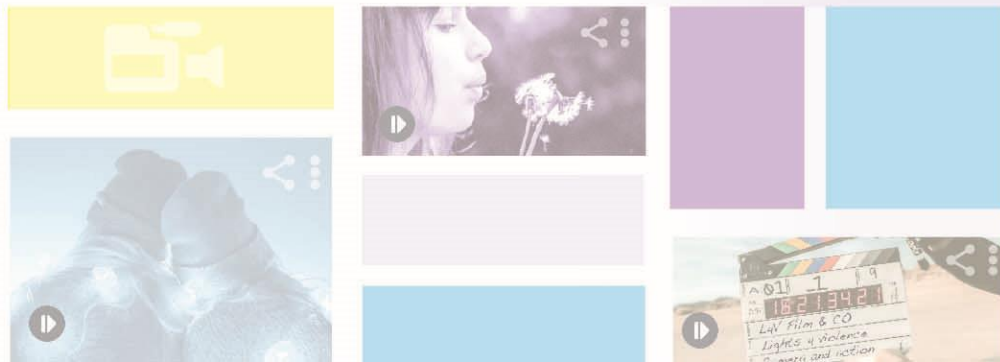

## 2. Teachers' training seminar



**DATA:** 6 september 2018

**DURATION:** One session (9h-17 h)

**PARTICIPANTS:** 25 teachers (3 from primary school)

## 2. Teachers' training seminar



High satisfaction with the training session

Excellent teachers' involvement and participation in proposed activities

Good chance to recruit proposals to improve the manual student activities

## 2. Teachers' training seminar: Main improvement proposals





To reduce images for identifying health assets

To ask only about positives aspects (images)

To include more space to answer questions about images

To refer to the assets preferably as good things

## 4. Planification for the workshop with student



### Period of the intervention
