

Lights4Violence: Manual for Teachers, Activities Manual and Instruction Manual for the Creation of Video Capsules

This Manual for Teachers explain the initial training module of the Lights4Violence Program. It is structured into two modules that are each composed of three or four sessions of approximately 50 minutes, in conformity with the length of the classes. Program development can be adjusted to the specifics of planning the work to give at least one session per week (although there is a certain margin for attending to unforeseen events that could arise during implementation).
